TDR Engineering Apprenticeship Programme

- Third year of the partnership
- Over 45 students participating a two year programme
- One quarter of the cohort were external admits
- Students gain the following qualifications:
- Level three BTEC Engineering
- Level two NVQ in performing Engineering operations
- Functional skills Level two in English, Maths and ICT
- Year two of programme students are employed and paid as an apprentice with a local engineering company and study in College one day per week

Excelsior Apprenticeship Programme

- Apprentice programme in its fifth year
- Level 2 and Level 3
- Apprentices offered to Excelsior students
- Expanded to LST academies
- Began with 2 roles, currently 12 roles
- To date most progress from Level 2 to Level 3
- Range of roles include;
- HR Administrator, Finance Assistant, Marketing & PR, Reprographics
- IT Technician, Curriculum Support Worker, Catering Assistant

Excelsior Employment

- 50% of CSW roles in our Primary have come through our apprenticeship programme
- Administrator and our Marketing & PR apprentices have completed this month and have now been offered permanent contracts
- Apprenticeship programme forms part of our staffing model/budget planning
- The number of apprentices meets the requirements of the Apprenticeship Levy
